The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Eric Skoog, Chairman presiding. All members were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board recognized the change of status of Alyssa Willenborg from Part-Time to Full Time Clinical Manager in the Public Health Department.

The Board recognized the following Underground Utility Permits:

No. 18-14 – Frontier Communications – Boring a fiber optic cable along Donna Reed Rd. commencing at US Highway 30 thence south along the west side of Donna Reed rd to a point 400 feet south of the intersection with Fairlane.

No. 18-15 – NIPCO – replacing an overhead electric cable cross E16 ½ mile east of the intersection with 240th St.

The Board met with Chuck Etleman to discuss fund balances.

A motion was made by Blum, seconded by Ulmer to approve the re-naming Channel 5 to EMS Ops with Crawford County Memorial Hospital paying half and Crawford County paying half of the \$6550.00 cost.

Voting Aye: Schultz, Blum, Ulmer, Skoog. Voting Nay: Muhlbauer. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Ulmer, seconded by Schultz to re-assign county held tax certificates: CH1700196, CH1700197, CH1700198, CH1700199, CH1700200, CH1700201, CH1700202, and CH1700203 to Jakob Sachau for a total of \$610.00 with \$438 to be paid to assign certificates, and the remaining due when deeded.

Motion was passed unanimously.

The Board met with, Amy Pieper and Terri Martens from the Crawford County Auditor's Office; Scott Utech from Teamsters Local Union #554; Todd Perdeu and Sheriff James Steinkuehler from the Crawford County Sheriff's Office and Rick Franck to discuss a Sheriff's Union Grievance.
