A discussion was made by the Board to allow the Burn Ban for Crawford County to expire.

A motion was made by Rosburg, seconded by Heiden to approve Cellsite Solutions LLC contract for LMR Towers Shelters.

Motion was pass unanimously.

During Citizen Input there were citizens here to express their concerns about the pipeline and wind tower construction.

On motion duly seconded the Board adjourned at 11:50 o'clock A.M.
