The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Ty Rosburg, chairman presiding. Members present were Schultz, Dozark, Rosburg, Muhlbauer, and Heiden.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board approved the change of wage for Nolan Schmidt, Maintenance Employee II, Engineer's Office.

The Board approved the change of wage for Elliott Kock, Maintenance Employee III, Engineer's Office.

The second Tier Canvass was conducted by the Board of Supervisors for the City/School Election held November 7, 2023. Copies of the Canvass and abstracts are available in the Auditor's Office.

A motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Muhlbauer to approve the following resolution:

RESOLUTION 2023-34

RESOLUTION ORDERING A RECOUNT OF VOTES IN THE PRECINCTS IN CRAWFORD COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Auditor's office administered the City/School Election of November 7, 2023; and
WHEREAS, the Crawford County Board of Supervisors on November 14, 2023, canvassed and certified the results of said election per the Code of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Stephens, candidate for Mayor of Arion, properly filed a request for a recount of votes in City of Arion mayoral race of DCAB precinct in Crawford County as prescribed by Code of Iowa §50.48;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Crawford County Board of Supervisors that a recount of said precincts be ordered and that the County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections be authorized to conduct said recount as prescribed by the Code of Iowa.

Voting Aye: Schultz, Dozark, Rosburg, Muhlbauer, and Heiden. Motion was passed unanimously.

Jodi Presswood, Elderbridge Agency on Aging, presented the Board with Elderbridge's annual report and updates.

Tyler Christensen from Assured Partners had a discussion with the Board about ISAC Group Health Plans.

A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Muhlbauer to approve to strike language "if at least 1,200 regular hours are worked in an anniversary year." Also strike language "All employees who work 1,800 regular hours in an anniversary year and after completing one full year of employment shall be entitled to 100% of vacation time and pay as indicated herein." From, Vacation Pay Upon Termination in the Crawford County Employee Handbook & Policies.

Motion passed unanimously.
